TRIPS & ACTIVITIES RULES & REGULATIONS

- All events are open to New Providence Senior Citizens Center members and a spouse, partner or guest. (New Providence residents need only sign a blue card for membership.)
- Tickets to all events will be sold on Wednesday meeting days starting four to six weeks prior to the event at 9:45AM and ending at 10:45 AM, or they may be purchased at the Center during its regular hours. Payment is necessary when reservations are made. There is a two ticket limit per person for bus trip reservations.
- A minimum of 40 members or New Providence residents are required for chartered bus trips. Space on the New Providence Seniors Bus is limited to 24 seats.
- Non-resident attendees are charged an additional \$5 for daily bus trips, luncheons and dinner parties. Their names will be placed on a waiting list when necessary.
- A refund, minus a \$5 handling fee, will be returned if a cancellation is made at least 48 hours prior to the event. For multi-day trips, the handling fee is \$5 per day and is required at the time of sign-up. Full refunds are given only when hospitalization or grave illness occurs. This cancellation policy is the same for all events, trips and meals.
- If a refund is requested, the Activities Committee will make the decision as to whether it will be accommodated.
- No show = no refund. Note: Times are start or bus leave times.
- Do not transfer your reservation to anyone else because there may be a waiting list and the transfer may not be honored. Preference will be given to the waiting list.
- If a New Providence senior needs the services of a caregiver to be present at a luncheon or dinner event held at the Center, that caregiver will be the guest of the Center for that event.
