AARP Smart Driver True/False Quiz

1. Drivers should place their hands at 8 and 4 o'clock or 9 and 3 o'clock, to reduce the chance of injury during an accident in which the airbag inflates.
2. To avoid making left turns on city streets, drivers should go to the next intersection then make three right turns.
3. If you're buying a new car, consider buying a lighter, brighter vehicle, as they are more visible to other drivers, especially at night or in rain.
4. When driving in the rain during the daytime, wearing polarized sunglasses can actually help you see better – even if there is no sun.
5. Use the three-second following rule when driving so that when you spot driving hazards ahead, you have time to react.

Daylight Saving Time ends on the first Sunday in November with the time change taking place at 2:00 a.m. local time. Remember to “fall back” by moving your clocks back one hour from 2:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.

Disaster Preparedness

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) recommends that we keep the following supplies on hand in order to survive for at least three days if an emergency occurs:

Basic Disaster Supplies Kit

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Manual can opener
- Local maps
- Cell phone with charger, inverter or solar charger
- Prescription medications and glasses
- Cash or traveler's checks and change
- Matches in a waterproof container
