### Answer guide




1. 1910 Acme Freezer Ice Cream Maker. 12" tall 8.5" wide. Made of galvanized tin.



2. Haha Coffee grinder 1920-40. Made of Iron Copper and wood. User would insert the coffee beans, turn the wheel to grind, and pull out the bottom drawer to collect ground coffee.



3. Carpet Beater made of metal and wood dimensions: rode 16.5", beater 12"x9" Was used to beat carpets with in order to shake dust and dirt out of carpets. Rugs were first hung on a laundry line then beaten. It was in common use until the vacuum cleaner became widely affordable.



4. Early 20th century electric toaster. The coils being in the center only toasted one side of the bread requiring the bread to be turned in order to toast the other side. Later invention would improve upon this and toast on both sides, with a pop up
