**PROCLAMATION CONGRATULATING THE NEW PROVIDENCE REDS
ON THEIR CHAMPIONSHIP WIN**

WHEREAS, The Reds were formed as the Whitehouse Reds in 2004 playing out of various home fields in Somerset County. The Reds were part of the Men's Adult Baseball League of New Jersey until 2013. In 2013 the New Jersey Amateur Baseball League was formed and the Reds joined that league and officially changed their name to the New Providence Reds, playing all home games at New Providence High School; and

WHEREAS, The team is comprised of both players from New Providence or current and former college players ages 18 and over; and

WHEREAS, The New Providence Reds competed in the Metal Bat Division of the NJABL for their first two seasons. In 2013 the Reds won their first championship in New Providence; and

WHEREAS, In 2014 the Reds won their second championship in a row, sweeping the Teaneck Yankees in two games in a best of three finals; and

WHEREAS, In 2015 the Reds switched from metal to wood bats and finished the regular season 15-3 to advance to the playoffs for the third straight year where they went 2-2 and lost to the Jersey City Scrappers in the league semi-finals; and

WHEREAS This past summer the Reds won the Championship title for the 3rd time in four seasons; and

WHEREAS The Reds have produced the league last three Cy Young award winners - New Providence's own Doug Pastore in 2014, and Scott Horowitz in 2015 & 2016.

NOW THEREFORE I, Allen B. Morgan, Mayor of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union and State of New Jersey, hereby heartily congratulate the Reds on their Championship win and wish them the very best of luck in the future.
